Starting July 2008, all CBP Officers will receive the higher law enforcement officer (LEO) retirement pension formula, as well as prospective early retirement.

Officers who accept the new coverage will receive a more generous law enforcement pension. Whether you work two more years or 20, you will benefit from this plan.

Your premium and overtime pay coverage will not be affected, and the mandatory LEO retirement age is waived for onboard CBP officers.

In the coming weeks, NTEU members will receive details on the new coverage, what they have to do to receive the increased benefits and how their pensions will be impacted.
